General Guidelines for Early Language

- Model, model model
- Watch and follow your child
 - Repeat routines
 - Focus on actions/ verbs


Core words: Learn the signs for these common words so your child can use the sign/gesture if they are not able to say the word.

Tip: If you are having trouble getting your child's attention, try this:

- Get down at eye level
- o Get close to your child
- o Give directions (Look at me, Look at my face)
- o Hold a toy near your face/mouth
- If the above don't work, withhold objects while you want them to look at you. Give the object back when they look at you and try to repeat you.

PLAYDOUGH



Some activities to try

- Make food items
- Take turns using a tool (plastic knife, roller, object to print)
- Make animals/ toys (look up a picture on google/kiddle)
- Roll a ball and throw it back and forth

Verbs

Model while your child is doing the action. If they continually do the same action, you can introduce different ideas and have them copy.

Cut Push Pull Poke Squeeze Roll Hide Throw Make (a ball, a snake, a pizza, a pancake, etc...)

2-word combinations

I roll You make Push fast Blue dough

Yellow dough My dough Cut more

More dough Big pizza Little snake



Some activities to try

- Move fast and slow, left and right, forward and back
- Move cars around the room on the table, up your leg
- Play hide and seek around the room with your cars
- Make car noises (e.g., vroom vroom, beep!)
- Hide cars in a bag and have your child guess what color will come out next.
- Put cars in a bucket with other items and cover with beans, sand, or water. Then have your child feel and touch to pull them out, saying the name of the item as they find it.
