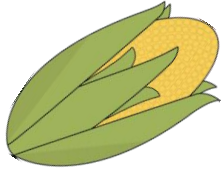
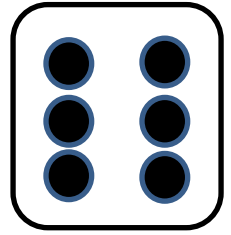
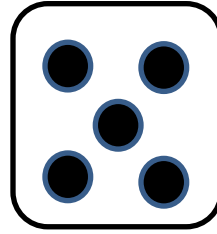
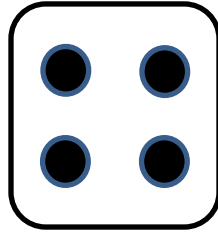
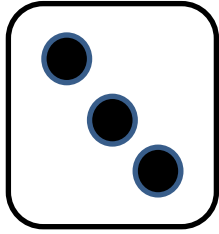
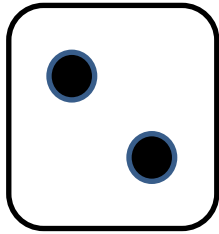
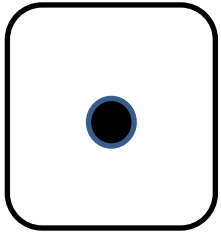


Silly Sentence Dice Roll - Initial K

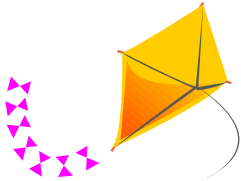
